Program Info

The **Songbook Organizer** is a web-based application for managing and displaying songs in ChordPro format. The Student Version offers all important functions for viewing, searching and exporting songs, without the risk of accidentally deleting or changing songs.

What is ChordPro?

ChordPro is a simple text format for displaying song lyrics with chords. Chords are placed in square brackets [C] directly before the corresponding word.

Example:

[G]Amazing [C]grace how [D]sweet the [G]sound

That [G]saved a [D]wretch like [G]me

Target Audience

- Music Students Safe usage without deletion risk
- Guitar/Ukulele Players Clear chord display
- Choirs and Bands Shared song collection



🚀 Quick Start

Starting the Program

- 1. **Open HTML File** in a modern web browser (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, Edge)
- 2. Automatic Loading All available songs are loaded
- 3. Start Page You see an overview of recently added songs
- 4. Choose Language DE German or GB English in header
- 5. Navigation Switch between tabs: Songbook, Song List, I Statistics

Understanding User Interface

- **Header** Title, language selection and master version button
- **Tab Navigation** Switch between different function areas
- Main Area Shows content of selected tab
- Song Cards Clear display of songs
- Song Viewer Detail view with chords

Main Features

Available Functions in Student Version:

- View and read songs Complete display with chords
- Search and filter By title, artist, genre, key
- **Export functions** Export songs as ChordPro, text or formatted
- **Chord display** Above text, inline or hide
- **Wultilingual** German and English
- **Statistics** Overview of song collection

O Unavailable Functions:

- Add or edit songs Only in Master Version
- **Delete songs** Only in Master Version
- **Import new songs** Only in Master Version
- Load/save songbook file Only in Master Version

The Songbook Tab

Main view for daily work

Search Area

- Search Field Enter song title or artist
- Search Button to start search (or press Enter)
- **X** Clear Reset all filters

Filter Options

- **Genre Filter** Dropdown list with all available genres
- **Key Filter** Selection by keys (C, D, E, F, G, A, B)
- Combinable Multiple filters simultaneously possible

Song Cards

Each song card shows:

- **Title** (large font)
- Artist (italic)
- Tags Genre, key, tempo, difficulty
- Action Buttons:
 - o **Wiew** Open song in viewer
 - o **ChordPro** Export as .pro file
 - o **Text** Export as .txt file

Song Viewer

Display songs in detail:

- 1. Click **View** on a song
- 2. The song viewer opens with complete text
- 3. Choose chord display:
 - o **Above text** Chords above text line
 - o **In text** Chords highlighted inline
 - o **Hide** Text only without chords
- 4. **X Close** Close viewer again
- **Tip:** The viewer also shows metadata like key, tempo and genre.



The Song List

Table view of all songs with export functions

Table Navigation

- Sortable Click on column headers
- Clear All song information at a glance
- **Responsive** Works on smaller screens too

Multiple Selection

- 1. **Individual selection -** Click checkboxes for desired songs
- 2. Select all Mark all songs at once
- 3. □ **Deselect all** Remove all marks
- 4. Master checkbox Checkbox in table header for quick selection

Batch Export

After selecting multiple songs:

- **Belected as ChordPro (.pro)** Keep original format
- Selected as Text (.txt) Text only without chords

Individual Song Export

Each song can also be exported directly:

- **Button** ChordPro export
- **Button** Text export

Tip: Individual songs can be exported via the ♠ (ChordPro) and ❷ (Text) buttons in the action column.

■ Statistics

Overview of your song collection

The Statistics tab shows four main metrics:

- Total Songs Number of all songs in collection
- Genres Number of different music styles
- Avg Tempo Average tempo of all songs with BPM indication
- Most Common Key The most used key
 - **Tip:** Statistics are automatically updated and help with overview of the collection.



Export Functions

Understanding File Formats

ChordPro Format (.pro)

- Complete Keeps all chord information
- Compatible Can be imported into other ChordPro programs
- Metadata Contains key, tempo, genre etc.

Example content:

```
{title: Amazing Grace}
{artist: Traditional}
{key: G}
[G]Amazing [C]grace how [D]sweet the [G]sound
That [G]saved a [D]wretch like [G]me
```

Text Format (.txt)

- **Text only** Without chords, only pure song lyrics
- **Print-friendly** Ideal for printing lyrics
- Compact Smallest file size

Example content:

```
Amazing Grace
by Traditional
=========
Amazing grace how sweet the sound
That saved a wretch like me
```

Formatted Text (.txt)

- Readable Text with chords above lines
- Musician-friendly Ideal for printing for instrumentalists
- Clear Chords and text clearly separated

Example content:



Export Tips

- 1. **Individual songs** Use buttons in song cards or table
- 2. Multiple songs Select multiple songs in song list
- 3. **Separate files** Each song is downloaded as its own file
- 4. **Download folder** Files go to your browser's default download folder
- 5. **File names** Automatically generated as "Title Artist.extension"

⚠ **Important:** With multiple selection, downloads are started one after another (300ms delay between files).

? FAQ

General Questions

? Can I add my own songs?

No, in the Student Version no songs can be added, edited or deleted. These functions are only available in the Master Version.

? What is the Master Version button?

The Master Version button in the header allows switching to the extended version with all functions. This requires a password that only teachers or administrators have.

? Why do I only see 9 songs in the songbook?

The Songbook tab only shows the 9 most recently used songs for better overview. All songs can be found in the Song List tab.

? Are my search filters saved?

No, search terms and filters are reset when the page is reloaded.

Technical Questions

? Can I use songs offline?

Yes, once loaded songs work without internet connection, as long as you don't reload the page.

? Which browsers are supported?

The application works in all modern browsers:

- Google Chrome (recommended)
- Mozilla Firefox
- Safari
- Microsoft Edge



? Why aren't some songs found?

Check:

- Spelling in search field
- Active filters (genre, key)
- Click X Clear to reset all filters

? Does it work on smartphones?

Ves, the application is responsive and works on desktop, tablet and smartphone.

Export Problems

? Export doesn't work?

Check:

- 1. **Pop-up blocker** of browser deactivated
- 2. Download permissions checked
- 3. **Storage space** sufficient available
- 4. Multiple downloads browser may only allow limited simultaneous downloads

? Where do I find the exported files?

The files are saved in your default download folder (usually "Downloads").

Technical

System Requirements

Browser Requirements:

- Modern web browser (see FAQ list above)
- JavaScript enabled Absolutely required
- No installation Runs directly in browser
- Platform independent Windows, Mac, Linux, iOS, Android

Hardware Requirements:

- Minimal RAM 512MB available
- Internet connection Only required for first loading
- Screen resolution At least 800x600 (recommended: 1024x768 or higher)



Data Processing

Privacy and Security:

- Local processing All data is only processed in browser
- No transmission Songs are not sent to external servers
- Offline capable No internet connection needed after loading
- No registration No user account required

Files and Storage:

- Automatic loading Songs are loaded from server at startup
- Browser downloads Exported files in download folder
- No auto-backup No automatic backup
- Cache storage Browser stores data temporarily

Troubleshooting

Page doesn't load properly:

- 1. Clear browser cache Press Ctrl+F5 (Windows) or Cmd+R (Mac)
- 2. Check JavaScript Enable in browser settings
- 3. Test different browser Use Chrome, Firefox, Safari or Edge
- 4. Internet connection Required for first loading

Songs not displayed:

- 1. **Songbook.json available** File must be present on server
- 2. Network problems Open browser developer tools (F12)
- 3. Contact administrator For persistent problems

Performance problems:

- 1. **Close browser tabs** Fewer open tabs = more memory
- 2. Clear cache Remove outdated data
- 3. **Restart browser** Free up memory
- 4. **Restart computer -** For serious problems

Browser Developer Tools

For advanced users (press F12):

- Console tab Show JavaScript errors
- Network tab Check data transmission
- Application tab View LocalStorage contents
